Breakdown must not begin before 3 pm on Saturday and must be completed by 5 pm when the City of Sebring reopens the streets for traffic. Be sure to have a fire extinguisher and copy of your licenses and insurance on hand. Each vendor is responsible for collecting Florida sales tax on sales made during the festival. RCHC will not provide any tents, tables, chairs, extension cords, or any other items for your booth or space. Upon arrival you must register at the RCHC booth.
